PROJECT NEWS:

The **third partner meeting** took place in **Pisa (IT)** 26th – 27th March 2019 where partners discussed **The Second Training Event** organisation planned at the beginning of September in *Granada, Spain*.



The partners dedicated their time also to the organisation of the **Project Final Multiplier Event** in *Brussels* in the last week of November 2019, the participation of international guests and representatives of European Institutions is envisaged.
