ABOUT THE PROJECT

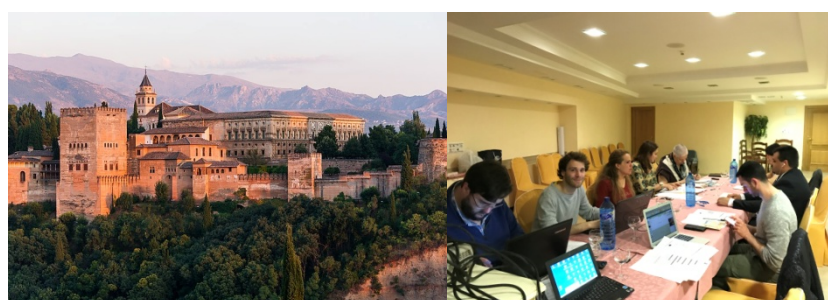
VIP and new technologies: easy access to job market (VIP-TECH-JOB) aims to empower young visually impaired people in their quest to find a job through social media and prepare them for a job interview via online and offline trainings.

The main objectives of the project are:

- 1) **to equip** young visually impaired persons (18-35 years old) with soft skills via on-line platform training courses to increase their success during a job interview;
- 2) **to empower** young visually impaired persons in using social media (Linkedin, Facebook groups, Twitter ...) in order to look for a job by using a new app that will be developed during the project;
- 3) **to increase** the confidence of young visually impaired persons in their capacities in accessing new professions;
- 4) **to increase awareness** of public agencies, unemployment offices, employers that it is possible and highly desirable to make our society more inclusive and supportive with young persons with visual impairment by using new adapted technologies.
